**Unfounded:** An allegation that was investigated and determined not to have occurred.

The Freeborn County Jail has a zero tolerance policy toward all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment in our facility, under the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) 2003. We will

enforce all federal, state, and local laws pertaining to inmate sexual misconduct. All reports will be fully investigated, which includes both allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment.

The Freeborn County Jail's continued commitment to maintain an organizational culture of zero-tolerance toward all forms of sexual abuse and harassment through annual staff training, contractor and volunteer training, notification to all professional visitors, and inmate education is supported by comparing the final statistics for the previous three years. In 2023, we had 1 unsubstantiated inmate on inmate complaint. In 2024, we had 3 unsubstantiated inmate on inmate complaints, 1 unfounded inmate on inmate complaint, and 1 substantiated inmate on inmate complaint. In 2025 we had 2 unsubstantiated inmate on inmate complaints.

The Freeborn County Jail redacts all personal identifies (name of victim, date of birth, sex of victim, date reported, and reporting party) when reporting annual statistics.
